Pima Federal ended 2019 with record earnings of \$8.8 million, and assets of \$600.6 million, ending the year with a strong capital ratio of 11.72%. Additionally, membership grew by 3%, resulting in 62,323 members at year-end. Through managing operating expenses and improved earnings, we have continued to maintain the fewest and lowest fees, increase deposit rates, and remain competitive on loan rates – all with you in mind, our valued member.

The following are notable achievements in 2019:

- Increased dividends paid to members 101% year over year.
- ► Maintained the lowest and fewest fees among peers.
- Growth in the balance sheet increased net interest income to new levels.
- Diversified the loan portfolio; Increased business and home loans while reducing dependence on auto loans purchased from dealers.
- Offered new deposit products and credit cards for business members.
- Opened a new branch in Sahuarita.
- Enhanced our digital banking app.

In closing, I'd like to offer my sincere appreciation to our Board of Directors, volunteers, and staff for their continued dedication to the credit union and our membership. It is because of your service, support, and commitment to our shared values that we continue to flourish.
